Construction of a series new publicly accessed squares, one of which is built off an existing Podium slab. This was cut away in areas to form atria and rc constructed, granite clad folding lawns. In addition the construction of a feature white RC planter raised some 3m above the ground and supported on stainless steel needle columns. The paved areas are specialist waterproofing systems, over laid with specially imported Chinese granite, which has a matrix of stainless steel channels to house fibre optic lighting that projects light from the joints of the paving up and onto the glass clad buildings. The M&E, including irrigation systems are also within our scope of works. Safety was paramount as all areas were kept accessible to the public.
